Policy:

University policy allows that a grade of D+, D, D-, or F may be disregarded in the calculation of the grade point average (GPA) if the student repeats the same course and earns another grade.

Explanation:

- 1. Both the original and repeated course must be taken at PSU.
- 2. Only the first D+, D, D-, or F grade can be disregarded, or excluded, from the calculation of the GPA
- 3. The second course (repeat) must also be graded (A-F). This grade is included in the calculation of the GPA. Transfer and correspondence courses are not eligible for this policy. Credit by examination and courses taken for Pass/No Pass are not included in GPA calculations, and are not eligible for this policy. Subsequent attempts after the second course repeat are not eligible for recalculation.
- 4. Original grades are not removed from the academic record (transcript).
